## PCM SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATION 2026 – 2027

### CIRCULAR

The PCM Scholarship Examination provides an excellent platform for students to demonstrate their knowledge and compete in various subjects. It aims to assess scholastic aptitude, mental ability, conceptual understanding, and problem-solving skills. Participation in such examinations helps enhance students' confidence and prepares them for future competitive examinations. This year, the examination is open to students of LKG, UKG, and Classes 1 to 5.

#### I. Examination Pattern

- **Pre-Primary:**
  - LKG** : Oral and activity-oriented test supported with pictures.
  - UKG** : Test for identification of objects and colouring activity supported with pictures.
- **Classes 1 to 5:** Written test.

#### II. Examination Schedule

<b>Date of Examination</b>	: 10 October, 2026 (Saturday)
<b>Time</b>	: 10:30 AM - 12:00 Noon
<b>Declaration of Results</b>	: 9 December, 2026 (Wednesday)
<b>Registration</b>	: <b>Opens on 15 June and closes on 3 August 2026.</b>

#### III. Eligibility

English medium schools, following the syllabus of any Board of Examination can enrol their students in LKG, UKG, and Classes 1 to 5. Separate examinations will be conducted for students of each class. For enrolment in LKG, UKG, and Class 1, there must be a minimum of 10 candidates in each class. Similarly, at least 20 candidates must be there for class 2 to 5 put together. Less than this will not be accepted from any school.

#### IV. Syllabus

The syllabus is based on the academic curriculum of each level, with a focus on higher-order thinking skills such as application, analysis, synthesis, imagination, and creativity. Participating schools will receive copies of the syllabus for free distribution among the participants. #### V. Fees

The examination fee is ₹175 per candidate.

## VI. Awards and Scholarships

- **1<sup>st</sup> Position (each class)** : ₹15,000 Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate.
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> Position (each class)** : ₹12,000 Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate.
  - **3<sup>rd</sup> Position (each class)** : ₹10,000 Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate.
  - **4<sup>th</sup> Position (each class)** : ₹5,000 Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate.
  - **5<sup>th</sup> Position (each class)** : ₹3,000 Scholarship, Memento, and Merit Certificate.
- **LKG and UKG:** Each candidate scoring 90% and above: ₹300 Scholarship, Medal, and Merit Certificate.
  - **Classes I to V:** Candidates scoring 80% and above: ₹300 Scholarship, Medal, and Merit Certificate.
  - **Merit Certificates and Medals:** For candidates scoring 60% and above.
  - **School Awards:** Schools with excellent results will be honoured with Best School (State level) and Topper School awards (District level).

## VII. Registration Process

All registrations must be completed online through our official website [www.curriculumindia.com](http://www.curriculumindia.com).

- **Entering of Student Information:** Schools must submit the following information for each participating student: *Full Name, Class, Division, Parent's Name, and Parent's Mobile Number.*
- **Fee Payment:** Payments are to be made by parents/ school through the payment portal available on the website. Upon successful transaction, a receipt will be issued. The school can verify the registration status on the website.

**We request that you may kindly designate a teacher/staff member as an Examination Coordinator from your school and submit the name and contact number of that teacher at the time of registration.**

## VII. Examination Centres

Examination Centres will be established in all major towns and cities across India, with locations carefully selected to ensure convenience for the participating schools. Schools enrolling 150 or more students will be designated as Examination Centres at their own premises.

## IX. Staff Appointment

Schools are requested to allow PCM Council to use the services of their teachers as invigilators/ examiners at neighbouring centres. Interested teachers should register online and will receive an honorarium.

## X. Results and Presentation of Awards

Results will be published on 9 December 2026 (Wednesday) on our official website [www.curriculumindia.com](http://www.curriculumindia.com). The Mementoes, scholarships, certificates, and trophies for the candidates who win the top five positions from each class and the schools with commendable performances will be presented in a special function, which will be held in July 2027. All other scholarships and certificates will be sent to the respective schools in the same academic year itself.
